## Introduction

Sometimes, it's difficult to find your way in the garden. This year, we have created a map for the Elmsdale Community Garden. To help explain where plants are located, this guide will break down the contents of each planting area.

When reading each section, **plants are listed from back to front, left to right**. If multiple rows have been planted, the number will be in brackets: **(#)**. The planting areas have been organized as follows:

- 12 garden boxes, numbered **1 - 12**
- 13 additional planting areas, lettered **A - M**

When plants are ready to harvest, **we will highlight the planting area on the map and the contents in the guide.**

Updates on the garden will be regularly posted to our Facebook page and the Elmsdale Community Garden website. We will also post **signs in the garden to mark what is ready to pick**. This guide is not meant to be definitive – it is an aide to help you find plants in the garden.
