

Newsletter Advertising







EHCLA produces a monthly newsletter called the *Door to Door Reader*. In it, we promote our programs and services, as well as activities and events happening in the community. This newsletter is distributed via e-mail and is also posted and shared throughout community groups on Facebook.

There are four options for advertising in the newsletter:

- Full page ad: \$800 yearly (12 issues) or \$100 per issue
- ½ page ad: \$600 yearly (12 issues) or \$80 per issue
- ½ page ad: \$500 yearly (12 issues) or \$70 per issue
- Business card ad: \$50 per issue

Facebook Advertising

We keep these pages regularly updated with our programs and services, as well as information about activities and events happening in the community. When actively shared amongst community groups, popular events and posts have reached over 13,000 views.

Garden Advertising

The Elmsdale Community Garden was built through the generous support of our community. Help us keep the garden growing through regular support and we will gratefully add your name to the list of individuals, businesses and organizations to our list of garden supporters.

Options for garden advertising include:

Plaque on a garden box: \$50

Support a Pop Up Market: \$300

o Pop Up Markets are free fresh food giveaways held throughout the garden season in various communities in East Hants. We purchase produce from community partners at reduced rates. As a supporter, you are encouraged to join us at a pop up market. Bring along promotional material, set up a table (*) or help us distribute food to anyone who drops by. You can also choose the location and we will work together with you to find a time that works. You will be recognized in

a Facebook post promoting the event.





- Refill the Community Freezer: \$500
 - Fill the Community Freezer with tasty, home-cooked frozen meals. These meals are available for free to anyone in our community. As part of your support, you will be thanked in a Facebook post announcing the freezer has been re-filled. We also have the option to add a name or logo to the labels put on each of the frozen meals.
- * Please note that pop up markets are free events and the sale of goods and services are not permitted.

Garden Advertising cont'd

- Support a Community Meal: \$750
 - Community Meals are a free meal hosted out of the Elmsdale Legion. Our team of Community Garden staff and volunteers prepare the meals on site and distribute them first-come first served drive-thru style. We also have the capacity to serve a limited number of people via delivery through the East Hants Community Rider. As a supporter, you are welcome to set up a table with promotional items or help us distribute the meals. Please note that Community Meals are free events and the sale of goods and services are not permitted. You will be recognized in a Facebook post promoting the event.
- Support the Harvest Dinner: \$1000 (Maximum 5 Supporters)
 - The Harvest Dinner is our signature fall event. We serve up a 3-course meal made from locally-grown ingredients for \$10 per person. Attendees pick up their meals drive-thru style from our office at an assigned pick up time. This event has the capacity to feed up to 300 people. As a supporter, you will be recognized in all promotion for the event, including Facebook posts, event listings, newsletter promotion and on our website. You are also welcome to set up a table with promotional items (*) or assist in the preparation or distribution of meals.

Vehicle Advertising

The Community Rider has 3 large white vans and lots of space to help you reach a local audience. We will collaborate with you to find the best way to fit your message on our vehicles. The cost to produce, design and install the advertising materials are not included: we simply provide a vehicle for your message. Costs for advertising spaces are as follows:

- Outside advertising must be constructed with easy to remove materials
 - o 25" wide X 25" long: **\$450 yearly or 50,000 km** whichever comes first
 - o 33" wide X 25" long: \$600 yearly or 50,000 km whichever comes first
 - o 43" wide X 25" long: \$750 yearly or 50,000 km whichever comes first
 - o 52" wide X 25" long: \$900 yearly or 50,000 km whichever comes first
- Inside advertising
 - 8½" X 11" poster: \$25/monthMAX 4 per vehicle



Purchase or Donate a Vehicle

The Community Rider also happily accepts funds towards the purchase or donation of a vehicle. This level of support requires contributions of **at least \$10,000** or **the donation of a vehicle** to our service. This also requires approval of the vehicle by our staff to ensure it is a good match for our fleet.

For this phenomenal contribution, you get to:

- Name the vehicle
- Design or approve a name plaque
 - this plaque will remain on the vehicle for the lifetime of its service with EHCR
- Get recognized at a vehicle launch party with a ribbon cutting ceremony
- A ¼ page shout-out in our annual report with pictures from the ribbon cutting ceremony

Learner / Passenger Support
